### Offensive Play Call—The Leading of the Holy Spirit

<b>“DIVE PASS”</b> One back play action. Same rules as Slide protection. Pg. 14	
<b>PST</b> Block #2 DL (on-outside), poss. “PIN” from G	
<b>PSG</b> Block #1 DL. May choose to “PIN” a LB in A gap (Be right!)	
<b>C</b> BS A Gap to LB, poss. “LOCK, SORT, or OUT”	
<b>BSG</b> B gap to LB, poss. “LOCK, SORT, or OUT”	
<b>BST</b> C gap extended, poss. “LOCK, SORT, or OUT”	
<b>X</b> Route called. Possible sight in 3x1 set.	
<b>Y/H</b> PS- Route called possible Q off ILB. BS- must check #4 to flag	
<b>Z</b> Route called.
